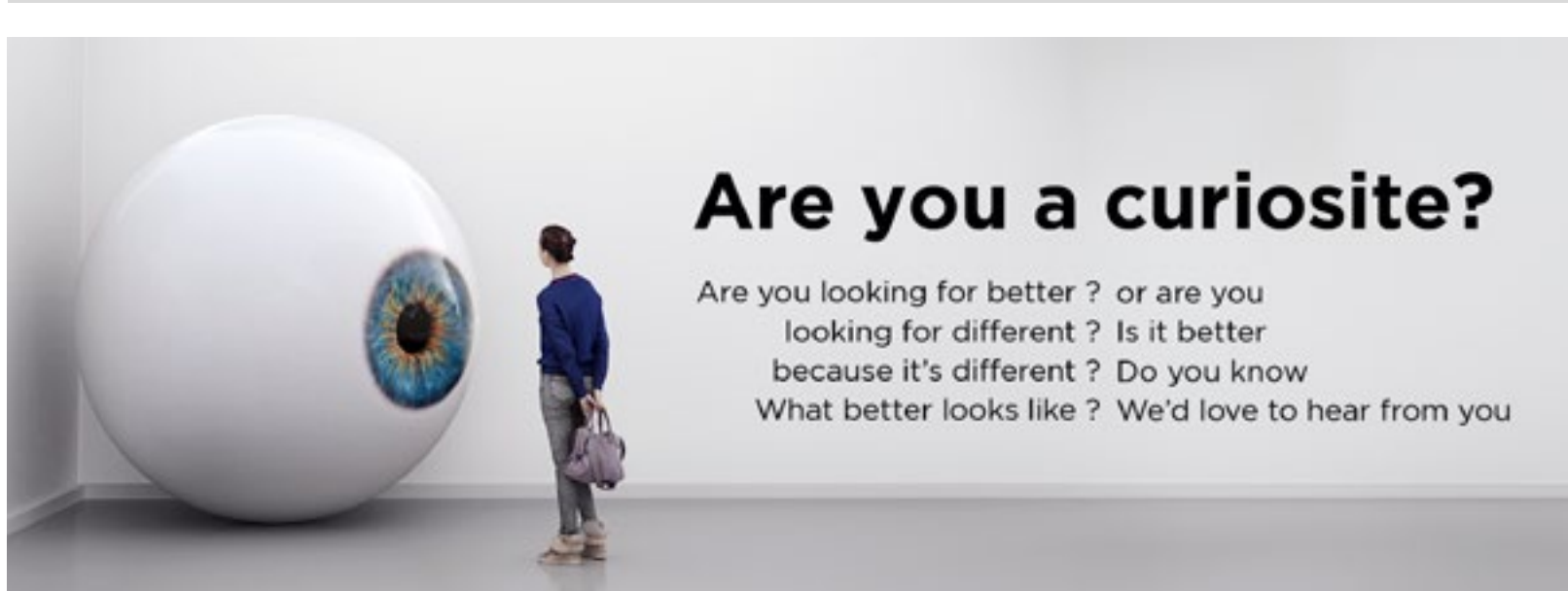


Resolving Employment Disputes Basildon, Chelmsford & Colchester
